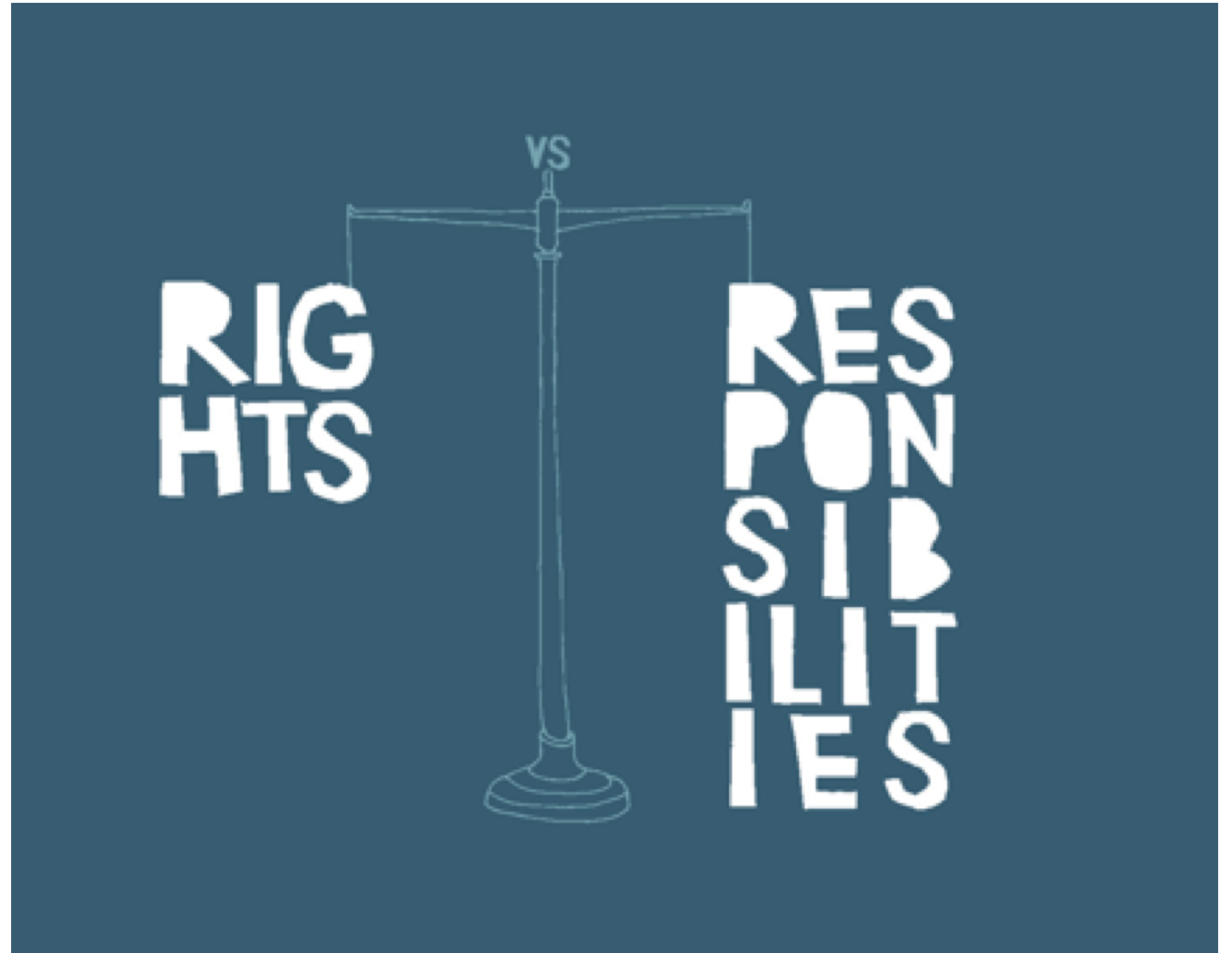


# Citizenship
