**imagination?** Provide specific details from the literature you have chosen that will support and develop your controlling ideas.

## January 1990

Write a composition based on literature you have studied in which the author examines self-discovery. **What idea does the author develop regarding self-discovery?** Provide specific details from the literature you have chosen that will support and develop your controlling ideas

#### June 1990

Write a composition based on literature you have studied in which the author examines the outsider. **What idea does the author develop regarding the outsider?** Provide specific details from the literature you have chosen that will support and develop your controlling ideas.

#### January 1989

Write a composition based on other literature you have studied in which the author examines turning points. What idea does the author develop regarding turning points? Provide specific details from the literature you have chosen that will support and develop your controlling ideas

#### June 1989

Select other literature that examines the effect of external or internal limitations on people's lives. **What idea does the author develop regarding limitations?** Provide specific details from the literature you have chosen that will support and develop your controlling ideas

#### January 1988

From other literature you have studied, choose one of two selections in which the struggle to come to terms with human isolation is examined. **What means has the author used to develop this theme?** Consider how elements such as character, setting, conflict contrast, symbolism, etc. reinforce the development of the theme. Support your ideas with specific examples from the literature you have chosen.

## June 1988

From other literature you have studied in your senior high school English courses, choose one or two selections in which the author examines the struggle to maintain identity through commitment to a belief, cause or goal. **What means has the author used to reinforce this theme?** Consider how elements such as character, setting, conflict contrast, symbolism, etc. Support the development of the theme with specific examples from the literature you have chosen.

## January 1987

Choose two other selections in which characters are influence by illusion and/or disillusionment and compare how the characters; attitudes and behaviors are affected.

## June 1987

Compare the personal quests of characters from two other selections that you have studied. Consider the motivations for the individual quests, the manner in which the characters deal with the situations they encounter in the course of their quests, and the outcomes of their quests.

#### January 1986

Compare two selections in which the authors show hoe people are affected by and respond to the prevailing conditions, attitudes or values of their society.

#### June 1986

Compare two selections in which the authors show that individuals are affected by and act in response to the attitudes and values of their families.

#### January 1985

Compare how the authors of tow selections have illustrated the idea that the positive forces of life are reaffirmed despite conflicts with destructive or threatening forces. Show how the authors you have chosen illustrate your ideas through setting, character and/or events. You must select from literature that you have studied in your senior high school English classes.

Compare how the authors of two selections illustrate the above idea through their use of setting, and/or character, and/or events. You must select from literature that you have studied in your senior high school English classes.
